(Matt. 5:21-30)

The “Sermon on the Mount” was, and still is, a new and higher form of doctrine. It amazed those fortunate enough to hear it in person (Matt. 7:28-29). It emphasized the spiritual nature of the coming new covenant versus the physical thrust of the Old (James 2:26). The inner man was now in focus. (2 Cor. 4:16)
